2016 ACA Basics

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What's covered

- Who is required to report under Internal Revenue Code Section 6055 and Section 6056;
- Information required by Section 6055 and 6056;
- Responsibilities of insured, self-funded major medical plans;
- Combined reporting for large employers that sponsor self-funded plans; and
- Clarifications and updates from the final IRS Forms 1094, 1095 and instructions.

In 2016, the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA) requires large employers and employers that sponsor self-funded plans to report extensive and detailed data for the calendar year that began January 1, 2015. Because the ACA's reporting requirements are complex and highly
