You may continue to deplete existing form inventory for a period of ninety (90) days* from the date of this message unless otherwise noted. Please begin using the revised forms as soon as possible. The revised forms will be available in the CSTARS e-forms folder and via the Revenue Website at www.revenue.state.co.us.

*Clarification of 90 day cut-off: Due to legislative changes or other factors which are date sensitive, the use of a new form may be required upon notification. Typically, when a new form revision is released, we allow a period of ninety days (90) from the date of notification for use of existing form inventory. For example, an end user who receives a form revision notice on July 1 could continue to utilize existing inventory through October 1. Transactions after October 1 would be completed on the revised form. The cut-off date is the use date, not the received date.
